

**POLICE SERVICE TECHNICIAN/TELECOMMUNICATOR (City of New Bern):** Performs vital and specialized support role on an assigned rotating shift receiving and dispatching emergency and routine calls for law enforcement, fire, emergency medical services, and other related agencies.
