Installs, maintains, and repairs low voltage power lines and related distribution system facilities; installs and repairs low voltage underground cable; operates line truck, auger, bucket truck, trenchers, and backhoes; hangs and removes transformers and wires up secondaries; hangs capacitors; installs, repairs, and replaces cross arms, leg supports, cable, insulator and lightning arrestors; performs required line work on de-energized circuits; responds to emergency calls and assists with a variety of problems under adverse weather conditions; works on standby on rotation basis and during emergencies; and performs related duties.
