FOUR ARRESTED FOR DRUGS FOLLOWING TRAFFIC STOP

Four men were arrested following an early morning traffic stop Saturday, January 23, 2010. Officers spotted a black 2000 Chevy Cavalier speeding down Cedar street around 2:30 a.m.

Police were able to stop the vehicle near Main and Murray streets. Four men were in the car, one of them, **Kelvin Mark BAUCOM** jumped out of the car to run, but was quickly apprehended by officers.

BAUCOM, 10/04/1984, of Suffolk, VA, was arrested and charged with Possession with Intent to Sell and Deliver Cocaine, Possession of Marijuana and Resist/Obstruct and Delay. He was placed in the Craven County jail under a \$20,000 bond.

Tyrone D. George, 110/23/1983, of 512 Second Ave., was charged with Possession with Intent to Sell and Deliver Cocaine, Possession of Marijuana and Resist/Obstruct and Delay. He was placed in the Craven County jail under \$20,000 bond.

Anthony Jay SIMMONS Jr., 09/23/1988, of 919 West St., and **Jeremy Antwez GEORGE, 08/05/1989**, of 181 Trent Court were both charged with Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Both were placed in the Craven County jail under \$1,000 bonds.
