TWO MORE ARRESTED FOR STOLEN TELEVISIONS

New Bern police have arrested two more suspects in connection to a string of break-ins at the Candlewood Suites Hotel at 3465 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. The hotel, which is still under construction, was broken into on three different occasions during the past two months, and more than 25 television sets were stolen from the location.

Dahriek BRADLEY, 04/24/1993, of 1410 Devers Circle, was arrested late Monday evening, and **Stevevonte Lamain THOMAS, 12/09/1990**, of 2918 Monroe Dr., was arrested Tuesday for the break-ins.

Both were charged with three counts of Breaking and Entering a Building and three counts of Larceny/Theft from a Building. **BRADLEY** was placed in the Craven County jail under a \$25,000 bond, **THOMAS** under a \$30,000 bond.

On January 8th, police arrested **Donwonta M. WEATHERSPOON**, for possession of stolen property in relation to the hotel break-ins. **Marcus De'Vonte Sequan DAVIS** was also arrested for the break-ins on January 22, 2010.

One television has been recovered, and the investigation is still on-going. Police expect more charges in the case.
