## FIGHT RESULTS IN ARRESTS

On June 9, 2011 at approximately 9:09 p.m., Officers of the New Bern Police Department responded to call about a fight on Fleet St between Pollock and Walt Bellamy Streets. Upon arrival, officers located a crowd of about 150 to 200 people with several fights occurring within the crowd.

Police located **Terrell ASKEW**, D.O.B. 6/08/1987 of 2878 Berkley Road, Wilmington, NC in the crowd. He was temporarily unconscious and had suffered minor facial lacerations and abrasions. **Terrell ASKEW** regained consciousness and refused medical treatment at the scene. He became disorderly by attempting to incite other fights and was placed under arrest for Disorderly Conduct and Resist, Obstruct and Delaying Officers. **Terrell ASKEW** had additional warrants on file for Misdemeanor Breaking or Entering from New Hanover County and was placed in the Craven County Jail under a \$5000.00 secured bond. His court appearance is set for July 19, 2011.

Terrell ASKEW's brother, **Delvin ASKEW**, D.O.B. 3/20/1983 of 723 Cypress Street, New Bern NC interfered with the arrest of his brother by attempting to pull Terrell Askew from police custody. **Delvin ASKEW** was charged with Resist, Obstruct and Delaying Officers. He was released on a Written Promise with a court appearance set for July 19, 2011.

**Tevin TAYLOR**, D.O.B. 1/30/1991 of 811 Pollock St, New Bern, NC appeared intoxicated in the crowd and had minor abrasions to his legs and face. Police asked **TAYLOR** to leave the area several times but refused. **TAYLOR** was arrested and charged with Failure to Disperse upon Command. He was taken before a Magistrate and released on a Custody Order with a court appearance July 19, 2011.
