“Police Responds to Shooting Incident”

At approximately 1:11 p.m. on March 1, 2011, officers of the New Bern Police Department responded to a call for a fight involving gunshots near Hamilton Drive in the Craven Terrace Housing Development. Officers located the victim and found that he had been involved in an altercation in front of B-2 237 Craven Terrace where he was shot. The victim has been identified as **Curtis SHAW**, D.O.B. 7/25/1971, of 1111 Cedar Street, New Bern, NC.

Emergency Medical Personnel responded and transported **SHAW** to Carolina East Medical Center where he was airlifted to Pitt Memorial Hospital. **SHAW** is currently undergoing treatment and is reported to be in stable condition.

Detectives are currently looking for a white vehicle, possibly a Nissan Altima occupied by a light complexion male wearing a white shirt and black pants that was seen leaving the area.
