STABBING INCIDENT AT TARGET

On May 20, 2011 at approximately 4:40 a.m., Officers of the New Bern Police Department responded to 3134 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd (Target) for a reported stabbing. CarolinaEast Emergency Medical Services was also dispatched.

Upon arrival, officers located **Sade FOYE**, D.O.B. 2/26/1987 of X-192 Craven Terrace, New Bern, NC and **Shadonna BERRY** also of X-192 Craven Terrace, New Bern, NC standing in the parking lot.

The investigation revealed that **Tiffany LOVE**, D.O.B 7/14/1990 of 1905 Stimpson Street, New Bern, NC was shopping in the clothing department when she was approached by **FOYE** and **BERRY** and an argument started between the three women. **FOYE** struck **LOVE** in the head and **LOVE** responded by hitting **FOYE** several times. **LOVE** then pulled out a knife to use against **FOYE** and **FOYE** attempted to flee the store. **LOVE** chased **FOYE** outside the store near the entrance where the knife was used three times to stab **FOYE**. **BERRY** was inciting the altercation the entire time. Unknown store patrons were able to separate the three women and **LOVE** was able to leave the area prior to police arrival. CarolinaEast Emergency Medical Services transported **FOYE** to CarolinaEast Medical Center where she was treated and released.

On May 21, 2011 police arrested **FOYE** without incident at her residence on warrants drawn for Simple Assault and Public Disturbance. She was released on a Written Promise to Appear on June 16, 2011.

Police also arrested **BERRY** without incident at her residence on warrants drawn for Public Disturbance. She was released on a Written Promise to Appear on June 16, 2011.

Warrants are on file for **LOVE** on charges of Assault with a Deadly Weapon with Intent to Kill and Public Disturbance. Police is asking for any assistance on locating **LOVE**.
