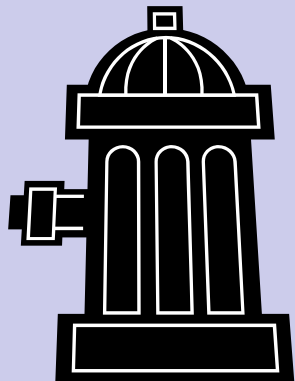


Summary

I had a great time at the Down East Dog Park. I'm ready for my nap now!



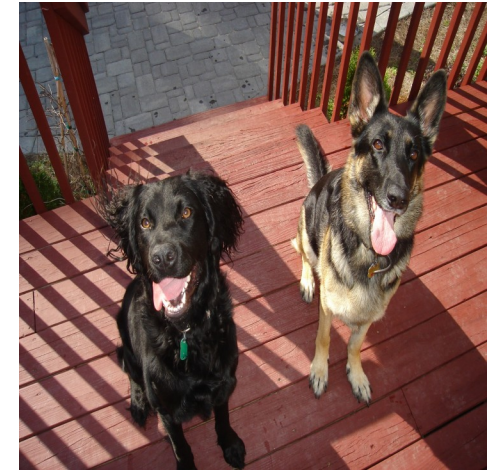

New Bern's Best Kept Secret The Down East Dog Park

Did you know New Bern has a dog park?

Beginning in June of 2006, New Bern Parks and Recreation began accepting applications for the Down East Dog Park. Since that time, the popularity of the park has grown. Last year, we had over 120 dogs registered.

Overview:

The City of New Bern's first dog park provides a place for owners to let their dogs run free in a safe area without a leash. This one acre fenced park features two areas to accommodate both small and large breed dogs.

Location:

The location is in Glenburnie Park at: 332 Glenburnie Drive.

Park Amenities

- Six-foot high chain link fence with paved entrance & electronic gate access
- Benches
- Water station
- Pet cleanup bags

What you need to do to Register

- Complete an application. You may either contact Parks and Recreation or download the application at: www.newbern-nc.org. Click on the Parks and Recreation page, under the parks tab, click on the dog park.



- Initial & sign the Acceptance of Responsibility and Risk, Release of Liability Form.
- Present your pet's rabies certificate.
- Pay your fee.

Fee Schedule

Annual membership runs from January to December.

Resident:

- Annual membership fee is: \$35.00 for first dog
- Additional dog in same family; \$20.00
- One month temporary membership is: \$15.00
- Weekend fee: \$10.00

Non-Resident

- Annual membership fee is: \$43.00 for first dog
- Additional dog in same family \$28.00
- Weekend fee: \$15.00
- One Month temporary memberships is: \$20.00

Dog Park Rules (condensed)

- Dogs must be registered with Parks & Recreation.
- Children under the age of 8 are not allowed in the park. Children between the ages of 9-12 are not allowed without adult supervision. Each dog using the park must be vaccinated against rabies and be healthy and parasite free.
- Each dog must wear a collar with identification and a Down East Dog Park tag.
- Dog owners must accept full responsibility for themselves and their dogs.
- Dogs over 25 lbs. must use large dog area only. Dogs 25 lbs. and under as well as dogs under 6 months old may use either area.



Dog Park Rules (continued)

- Owners must be present and physically able to control their dogs at all times. No more than two dogs at a time per owner.
- Owners are legally responsible for any damage, injury, or illness their dog(s) may cause.
- Each owner must carry a leash for each of his or her dogs.
- Dogs are not allowed to wear pronged or spike collars within the park
- Dogs showing aggression toward people or other animals must be removed from the park immediately by their owner.
- Dogs in heat are not allowed.
- Wolves and wolf hybrids are not allowed inside the park.
- Owners must clean up after their dogs.
- Potable water will be provided, but owners must supply water receptacles.
- Glass containers are not allowed in the park.
- Users and guests must not throw litter or cigarette butts on the ground. Use receptacles provided.
- Use of the park is limited to park hours from 7:00 a.m. until sunset.
