UPDATE POLICE INVESTIGATE HOME INVASION

The New Bern Police Department Criminal Investigations Section continues to investigate the Watson Avenue home invasion and shooting which occurred on March 28, 2016. Roy Nolan has been treated for his injuries and released from Vidant Medical Center. Tyriq Scott remains hospitalized in serious condition.

Detectives have obtained an arrest warrant for Scott, charging him with 1st Degree Burglary, which will be served on him when he is released from the hospital. Detectives are continuing their work and ask anyone with information to please call 252-633-2020.

POLICE INVESTIGATE HOME INVASION

On March 28, 2016 at approximately 1:30 a.m., officers responded to the 600 block of Watson Ave in reference to a home invasion. Once on scene, officers found both Roy Nolon, 18 yoa of New Bern and Tyriq Scott, 19 yoa of Vanceboro suffering from gunshot wounds. Both Nolan and Scott were transported to CarolinaEast Medical Center and then to Vidant Medical Center in Greenville, NC, where Nolan is listed in stable condition and Scott in serious condition.

At this point in the investigation, it appears the parties involved knew each other and this was not a random act. Detectives are actively investigating the incident, interviewing witnesses and following up on active leads.
