New Bern Police Department to Host *Coffee with a Cop* on July 8, 2014

The New Bern Police Department will host *Coffee with a Cop* on July 8, 2014, at 8:30 a.m. at Carolina Colours Pavilion, 503 West Thurman Road, New Bern. Officers from the New Bern Police Department and community members will come together in an informal and friendly atmosphere, to discuss community issues, build relationships, and drink coffee.

Coffee with a Cop provides a unique opportunity for community members to ask questions and learn more about the ways the department is making an impact in our neighborhoods. All community members are invited to attend.

The majority of contact law enforcement has with the public happens during emergencies or emotional situations. Those situations are not always the most effective times for relationship building with the community, and some community members may feel that officers are unapproachable on the street. *Coffee with a Cop* breaks down barriers and allows for one-on-one interaction in a relaxed environment.

“We hope that community members will feel comfortable to ask questions, bring concerns, or simply get to know our officers,” said Police Chief Toussaint Summers, “These interactions are the foundation of community partnerships.”

Coffee with a Cop is a national initiative supported by The United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services. Similar events are being held across the county, as local police departments strive to make lasting connections with the communities they serve.
