# New Bern Police Department

## Uniform Crime Report Statistics for Calendar Year 2005

Based on a total of **1,607** Part I Crimes in 2005 and the 2005 population for New Bern estimated at **26,468**, the resulting Crime Rate was **6.1%**.

Based on a total of **1,726** Part I Crimes in 2004 and the 2004 population for New Bern estimated at **25,684**, the resulting Crime Rate was **6.7%**.



In comparison, the State of North Carolina had **388,874** Part I Crimes in 2005 with a population of **8,421,102** for a resulting Crime Rate of **4.6%**.

# UCR Part I Crimes 2004-2005 Comparison



**Total Part I Crimes for 2004 were 1,726**

**Total Part I Crimes for 2005 were 1,607**

In raw numbers, there was a **7% reduction** in Part I Crimes from 2004 to 2005  
When adjusted for population changes, there was a **10% reduction** in Part I Crimes from 2004 to 2005
