UPDATE POLICE INVESTIGATE BANK ROBBERY

TYRONE MAURICE WILLIAMS, B/M DOB 11-29-85, streets of New Bern, was arrested and charged with Common Law Robbery of First Flight Credit Union in the 3100 block of M L King Blvd.

Further investigation resulted in **WILLIAMS** being charged with Armed Robbery with a Dangerous Weapon at Dollar General on July 24, 2012 and two (2) counts of Assault w/Deadly Weapon w/Intent to Kill Inflicting Serious Injury of two store employees shot during the robbery.

“The Police response to the bank robbery in other than ideal weather conditions and the persistence of Police Detectives assigned to the Dollar General case allowed for the apprehension of Mr. Williams”, said Chief T.E. Summers, Jr. “From the Police Telecommunicator to the Officers involved in the these investigations and the subsequent apprehension, all are to be commended for removing this dangerous criminal from our streets.”

WILLIAMS is being held in the Craven County Jail under a \$1,000,000.00 dollar bond with a first appearance set for February 12, 2014.
