
Police Investigate Homicide

On November 7, 2016 at approximately 12:36 a.m., officers responded to the 2900 block of Madison Avenue for a report of shots fired.

Officers found an unresponsive male who was transported to CarolinaEast Medical Center by Emergency Medical Services for treatment of his injuries. The victim, Terence Jerome Gardner, B/M, DOB 4/1/79, 815 Fowlers Lane, New Bern, N.C., was then flown to Vidant Medical Center in Greenville where he succumbed to those injuries.

The case is ongoing and anyone with information on the shooting is asked to contact the New Bern Police Department at 633-2022. At this point in the investigation, this incident does not appear to be a random act.
