Citizens Police Academy

The Citizens Police Academy is designed as an educational program to introduce citizens to the philosophy, policies, and guiding principles of the New Bern Police Department, as well as the ethical conduct governing police services in our community. Basic classroom instruction, presentations, and demonstrations are interactive and include participation in firearms training, firearms practice and riding with police officers on patrol.

The Academy is scheduled for ten (10) sessions on Thursday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and some Saturdays.

The Citizens Police Academy provides an opportunity for interested participants to learn about the department's daily operations, gain an informed perspective and share community concerns. The planned activities encourage communication which helps to build a strong citizen/police partnership. Everyone benefits from the partnership as we work together to share the responsibility of public safety.

The Citizens Police Academy is a ten (10) session program held once a week during a three (3) hour night class at the New Bern Police Department. The Academy is offered exclusively to residents and business leaders of Craven County.
