POLICE INVESTIGATE SHOOTING

Police responded to a call of shots fired on December 9, 2013 at 11:15 AM in the 2100 block of Alabama Ave. Upon arrival, officers found two subjects who had suffered gunshot wounds. Marcello L. Bryant, B/M, DOB 3/11/1981 of the 1200 block Asbury Rd., Cove City, was found in a vehicle located at Beech St. and Alabama Ave. Andrew L. West, B/M 6/2/1987 of the 900 block of Weyerhaeuser Rd., Vanceboro, was found in a yard at Dail St. and Florida Ave. Both subjects were transported to CarolinaEast for treatment. West was pronounced dead at CarolinaEast and Bryant was transported to Vidant Medical Center in Greenville. A third subject, Terrell D. Evans, B/M, DOB 7/28/1984 of the 2100 block Carolina Ave. was at CarolinaEast upon officer's arrival at the hospital.

A person on scene was transported to the New Bern Police Department for questioning and determined to be the shooter. He is cooperating with law enforcement as the investigation continues and the community has no cause for alarm. At this point in the investigation this appears to be an isolated incident.
